#### How to get to venue:

#### By plan:

Cambridge is within easy reach of London Heathrow, London Gatwick & London Stansted Airport.

London Stansted is the nearest international airport to Cambridge, located just 30 miles to the South of the city, with easy access by train, coach, or car (M11).

EasyJet and Ryanair fly from Stansted.

## By train

There are frequent direct trains from Cambridge to London

- to King's Cross via Royston, Hitchin, Stevenage, Finsbury Park, etc.
- ✤ to Liverpool Street via Audley End, Bishop's Stortford, Harlow Town, etc.
- (but note that many services stop at only a few of the intermediate stations).

Direct trains are also available to: Birmingham, Bury St Edmunds, Ely, Ipswich, King's Lynn, Leicester, Liverpool, Manchester, Newmarket, Nottingham, Norwich, Peterborough and Sheffield.
